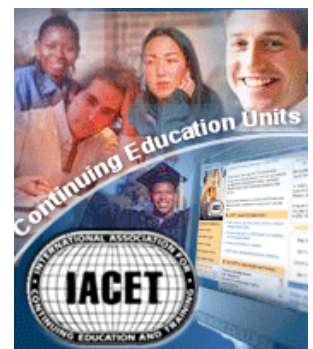

Following are The SuperSlow Zone Institute (SSZI) 2006-2007 Re-certification Continuing Education (CEU) Guidelines. From time to time, the SSZI Policies and Procedure may change.

A. SuperSlow Zone Institute

1. SSZI Code of Professional Conduct

Certified SuperSlow Instructor credential holders are expected to comply at all times to the SSZI Code of Professional Conduct. See below.

Use of SuperSlow® Trademark and Methods Patents

I understand and agree to the specific guidelines surrounding the use of The SuperSlow Zone trademark granted to you as a certified Level I SuperSlow Zone instructor.

My acknowledgement is part of signing this Agreement.

- a. It is understood and agreed that, as a certified SuperSlow instructor, I may indicate my level of certification on my business cards only. If I am a SuperSlow Licensed Facility Owner, I may use the SuperSlow registered trade mark according to the agreements specified in my Licensed Facility Agreement.
- b. I understand, however, that I may not use the distinction of being a certified Level I, Level II or Master SuperSlow instructor in any form of advertising, print media, letterhead, etc., other than my business cards or I am a Licensed SuperSlow facility.
- c. I understand that being a certified Level I, Level II or Master SuperSlow instructor does not grant me the right to open a SuperSlow facility using the SuperSlow trademark and methods patents. The opportunity to do business using the SuperSlow trademark and methods patents is now under the auspices of The SuperSlow Zone, LLC.
- d. I understand that being a certified Level I SuperSlow instructor does not authorize me to teach and/or certify individuals to use or become certified as a certified Level I SuperSlow instructor, unless I am an appointed Master. That authority is strictly at the direction of The SuperSlow Zone, LLC.
- e. I understand that as a certified Level I, Level II or Master SuperSlow instructor I may not speak on behalf of or represent The SuperSlow Zone, LLC, or any of its affiliates in any capacity, including but not limited to print media, video tapes, television, radio, and other form of communication.
- f. I understand that being a certified Level I, Level II or Master SuperSlow instructor does not endow me with any special consideration regarding the purchase of SuperSlow Zone exercise equipment.

2. Be A SSZI Member in Good Standing

Every certified SuperSlow credential holder is required to join and remit their membership fee to SSZI in advance of CEU(s) registration. To be in good standing means that the SSZI member fulfills all SSZI membership agreement.

B. Continuing Education Units (CEU)

As stated on the IACET Web Site

1. Purpose

The Continuing Education Unit (CEU) was created to:

- provide a standard unit of measure,
- quantify continuing adult education and training activities, and
- serve the diversity of providers, activities, and purposes in adult education.

2. Definition

One CEU = ten contact hours of participation in organized continuing education/training experience under responsible, qualified direction and instruction.

3. Ownership and Use of the CEU

The International Association for Continuing Education and Training (IACET) is the caretaker of the CEU. IACET assumes responsibility for refining and disseminating information about the CEU. Through its programs, publications, research, and technical assistance, the Association assists organizations in correctly utilizing the criteria.

The CEU is in the public domain. Use of the CEU is voluntary and no permission or approval is required. The decision to award the CEU is made by the provider and should be based on a thorough review of the provider's capabilities in meeting the IACET CEU criteria.

Any organization can offer the traditional CEU. Unfortunately, there are organizations which award the CEU which do not adhere to the standards developed by the IACET. This has led to consumer misunderstanding and distrust of the value of the CEU. Therefore, IACET has taken steps to ensure the credibility of the IACET CEU.

4. Authorized Providers

SuperSlow Zone Institute is an IACET Authorized Provider.

To ensure quality in continuing education and training programs and to increase the consumer's confidence in those organizations which adhere to the standards, IACET established the Authorized Providers Program. This program provides recognition for providers who adhere to the criteria and are willing to have their programs assessed by the Authorized Providers Commission.

5. IACET CEU

To distinguish between the generic CEU and the CEU granted by IACET Authorized Providers, the IACET restricts the use of its IACET CEU and Authorized Provider logos to providers which are approved as Authorized Providers by IACET.

1. Background

WHEREAS, SSZI and the Student desire to engage in SuperSlow Re-certification, the Student understands and agrees to the following policy and procedure terms and conditions set forth herein.

2. Purpose of SSZI Continuing Education

Re-certification for SuperSlow by fulfilling CEU requirements is intended to promote continued development of the Certified SuperSlow Instructor's knowledge, competence, and practical skills.

This ensures that certified SuperSlow Instructors continually develop as professionals who safely and successfully administer SuperSlow exercise methodology.

3. Eligibility for SuperSlow Re-certification

- ANY certified SuperSlow Instructor (includes Level I, II and Master) may choose to recertify.
- Re-certification is not dependent on who you work for.
- If you are a certified SuperSlow Instructor, and *you choose to recertify*, you may do so by fulfilling I.A.C.E.T. Re-certification CEU requirements.

SuperSlow Master	2

7. Ensuring Your CEU Courses Fulfill the Total Required CEUs Specified For Your Level

CEUs are earned by completing course requirements. Each course will have a specified CEU value (e.g. .25 CEU, .5 CEU or 1 CEU).

You will ensure that the number of CEU courses you take will fulfill the **total required CEUs specified for your level**.

8. How I Can Take CEU Courses

I can take CEU courses through:

- 'Distance learning' - such as 'tele-classes, web casting, etc.
- 'In person' - at a convention, conference, summit or at a specific location hosting the CEU course, etc. (in 2007, we will advise you about the possibility of a conference or summit; please ensure that your contact information is always up to date with the SSZI Registrar, Roxie Borisch registrar@sszi.com)

9. CEU Course Hour Requirements

- "1" CEU = 10 hours
- "1.5" CEUs = 15 hours
- "2" CEUs = 20 hours

11. Understanding Why CEU Requirements for SS Level II and Masters Different Than SS Level I Instructors

With a progression in skill levels; e.g., SS Level II and Master, the requirements for Re-certification increase.

12. How Long Do I Have To Complete My CEUs?

Please read #4, **Maintaining SuperSlow Certification Credentials By Re-certification** to understand how long you have to fulfill your CEU course requirement for your SS certification level.

14. Re-certification CEU Fee(s)

Every certified SuperSlow credential holder is required to register and remit Re-certification CEU fee(s) to SSZI based on the payment terms selected at the time of each CEU course registration.

15. Payment for CEU Courses

I understand and agree to pay for the CEU courses I select based on the payment method I agree to when I register for each CEU course.

16. Course Evaluation

Course Evaluation: **Completion of the Course Evaluation is required by each student to receive your CEU for the course:**

- Each student agrees to fill out a Course Evaluation and ensure it is received by the SSZI within 10 business days of the course completion.
- This is required by IACET, our accreditation organization.
- **Not completing and returning your Course Evaluation within ten business days from the date of course completion, will delay being awarded your CEU for this course.**
- Fax your evaluation to: (503) 304-2960, press the 'start key' during the message or PDF it to evaluations@sszi.com

17. Recording and Reporting CEUs

The SSZI Registrar will record in each SSZI Student's permanent record completed and incomplete CEUs and report to the SSZI CECO.

18. Post-Event Evaluation

Each CEU course is evaluated by the registered student. The method of evaluation will be specified by CEU course registration. We anticipate our first event in the Spring, 2007.

19. Change of Address

Changes in mailing address must be provided to SSZI by the Student.

Failure to maintain a current mailing address will make it difficult for SSZI to keep you informed and may result in suspension or revocation of the SSZI credential because we can not contact you.

20. Missing a CEU Course(s) That You Have Registered For

All classes and course work specified by the CEU course must be attended in order to receive your credit(s).

However, if you miss **one class**, you may have one 'class make-up' purchasing and listening to the audio CD recording of that class.

If you miss more than one class specified by your CEU course, it is considered forfeited and there is no refund.

a) Course Make Up Requirements:

If you miss **one class**, you may make it up by purchasing the audio CD recording of the missed class. This applies to only one class within a CEU course.

- Course Make-up Fee: the **fee for the course make-up audio CD is**
 - \$28 for U.S., includes shipping and handling
 - \$33 for International, includes shipping and handling
- **If you miss more than one class, you forfeit your CEU credit for the course.**
 - **You may continue taking the course if there are remaining classes, but No Credit will be earned for the class.**

21. Repeat a CEU Course:

a) For Credit:

You may repeat a CEU course that you did not pass or complete by submitting the required registration and payment information.

- If you purchased the course materials at an additional cost, and at the time of repeating your course they have not changed, you may reuse these materials.
- **Updated Course Materials: Note that courses are updated and additional materials may be required. Please check with the Registrar at the time of your repeat course enrollment.**

b) Audit the Course for No Credit:

By permission, and when class size permits, you may audit a course you previously completed by submitting the required registration and payment information.

- Note that “audit a class” means you may listen, but may not participate in class discussion.
- Auditing a course is by permission of the course instructor.
- ‘CEU credit’ for auditing your course will not be awarded.
- If the course has an assignment, test, and/or any other form of class requirement, you will not participate.
- There IS a reduced fee for auditing a course. Check with the Registrar for the prevailing ‘auditing course fee.’
- Course materials, if included when first enrolled, may be reused if unchanged.
- **Updated Course Materials: Note that courses are updated and additional materials may be required. Please check with the Registrar at the time of your repeat course enrollment.**

22. Retesting for a Failed Exam, When Applicable

Retesting for a written, practical or oral exam, when applicable, will be specified by each CEU course registration form.

23. CEU Course ‘Non Sufficient Funds (NSF) Penalty Fee’ Payment

‘Non sufficient funds penalty fee’ payment applies if:

- a. You pay for your CEU course with a personal check and there are insufficient funds to cover the check and/or
- b. You pay by credit card and the credit card is declined and/or
- c. You challenge a charge by SSZI on your credit card (a “charge back”) for which SSZI can demonstrate that you registered for and agreed to pay for a CEU course

‘Non sufficient funds penalty fee’ payment: \$30 per incident.

Payment of the \$30 penalty fee is due within 15 calendar days of receiving the notice of NSF.

24. CEU Course Cancellation And Rescheduling by Registrant

I understand and agree to the circumstances requiring:

- a) **Cancellation of CEU Course:** If you are unable to take a CEU Course that you have registered and paid for, then you must cancel 2 weeks (14 calendar days) before the first class or forfeit the entire class fee.
- b) **Notice of Course Cancellation – What To Do**
 1. **Contact the Registrar at coursecancellation@sszi.com**
 2. The following information must be included: Your Name, Your Telephone Number, Your e-mail Address, Date Course Begins, Name of Course, Course Number and Course Instructor.
- c) **Approval of Course Cancellation:** You will receive a confirmation by email or regular mail that your cancellation has been received and accepted or declined, and **you will be asked to acknowledge that you have received this notice.**
 - If sent by email, we will use the email address that we have on file for you when you registered unless otherwise indicated.
- d) **Administrative Fee (for course registration, un-registration, class logistics, coordination with instructor, etc):**
 1. There is a non-refundable \$35 administrative fee for each course that is cancelled regardless of when the cancellation is made.
 2. Exception: see Rescheduling Fee (e), below.
- e) **Rescheduling Fee** (rescheduling from one to another, logistics, coordination with instructor, etc.)

If you reschedule a substitute course at the time you cancel your course, you will pay only the rescheduling fee (\$25) and not incur the Administrative Fee of \$35, stated above.
- f) **Refund:** If a refunded course fee is applicable, you will receive your refund within 30 calendar days of your cancellation notice.
- g) **CEU Course Materials Fees Refund:**

There is no refund of course materials fees.

25. Expiration Policies of My SuperSlow Certification Credential

If I do not fulfill my Re-certification requirements listed in #9, above, I understand that my SuperSlow credential is revoked (null and void).

To reinstate my certification for SuperSlow Level I or Level II (“Master” level is ‘appointed’ by Ken Hutchins), I must re-register and re-take the SuperSlow Level I and/or Level II certification again under the new IACET standards.

26. Understanding of “Non-CEU Activities”

SSZI will be offering 'non-CEU activities' as enrichment opportunities for its members.

I understand that I may choose to take "non-CEU activities" to further my education, development and connection with the SuperSlow community (e.g. activities to be offered in the future are *SuperSlow Strength Training RoundTables with Ken Hutchins*, *Inside The Master's Studio*, *Open Mike With Ken Hutchins*, etc.) but these designated "non- CEU activities" **will not count** towards fulfilling my annual CEU Re-certification requirements.

27. Severability

In case any covenant, condition, term or provision contained in this Agreement shall be held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, in whole or in part, by judgment, order or decree of any court or other judicial tribunal of competent jurisdiction, from which judgment, order or decree no further appeal or petition for review is available, the validity of the remaining covenants, conditions, terms and provisions contained in this Agreement, and the validity of the remaining part of any term or provision held to be partially invalid, illegal or unenforceable, shall in no way be affected, prejudiced, or disturbed thereby.

28. Waiver or Modification

No waiver or modification of this Agreement or of any covenant, condition or limitation herein contained shall be valid unless in writing and duly executed by the party to be charged therewith. Furthermore, no evidence of any waiver or modification shall be offered or received in evidence in any proceeding, arbitration or litigation between the parties arising out of or affecting this Agreement, or the rights or obligations of either party, unless such waiver or modification is in writing and duly executed as aforesaid. The provisions of this paragraph may not be waived except as herein set forth.

29. Complete Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the Parties with respect to the subject matter of this Agreement and supersedes any and all previous agreements between the Parties, whether written or oral, with respect to such subject matter.

30. Applicable Law, Binding Effect and Venue

This Agreement shall be construed and regulated under and by the laws of Florida, and shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the Parties and their heirs, personal representatives, successors and assigns. Venue for any action related to or arising out of this Agreement shall lie in county of Dallas, TX.

31. No Third-Party Beneficiary

Nothing expressed or implied in this Agreement is intended, or shall be construed, to confer upon or give any person (other than the Parties and, in the case of, his heirs, personal representatives and/or legal representative) any rights or remedies under or by reason of this Agreement, unless specifically provided for herein.

32. Section and Paragraph Headings

Section and paragraph headings used throughout this Agreement are for reference and convenience and in no way define, limit or describe the scope or intent of this Agreement or affect its provisions.

33. Multiple Copies or Counterparts of Agreement

The original and one or more copies of this Agreement may be executed by one or more of the Parties. In such event, all of such executed copies shall have the same force and effect as the executed original and all of such counterparts taken together shall have the effect of a fully executed original.
